## Occupy Madison

- New village coming to South Stoughton Rd
- More industrial area, which is not ideal for residents
- Plan to do some of the building/construction of tiny homes on this site
- Other long-term villages at Johnson & 4th, Aberg Ave
- Stoughton Road <u>plan</u> comes into play for land use

#### Building energy assessment rules

- Policy recently introduced in council
- Requires commercial buildings to do energy audits regularly
  - This includes nonprofits and religious organizations
  - Residential structures are not under requirement
- Some maintenance requirements as well

- Overall costs are relatively low, with efficiency gains hopefully covering
- Erick can refer people to Jessica Price for specific questions

## Traffic

- Desired: left turn signal Cottage Grove and Acewood
- Increased pedestrian traffic with new apartment
- Behind on several approved traffic projects
- Erick said he will confer with traffic project list and get back to us
